

## **Bienvenida Spanish 3 Term 2**

**Basic:** welcome / date with year / time

**Weather:** 2 different weather commentaries

Talk about the weather in different places. Tell what you think, like or dislike about it and why. Talk! – don't just list vocabulary.

**Announcements:** 2 different announcements with specific details like day, date, time, place, cost, why go, so what, etc. One must be real- connected to Lone Peak - the other can be invented - but must still have a lot of detail.

**Intro:** Introduce yourself to the class. (name, age, where you are from, etc.) Include some favorite activities, likes, dislikes and basic info about your family, friends, hobbies, daily activities etc. Try to use lots of description and adjectives. Try different verbs.

**Graded on:** (100 points)

Pronunciation (Watch vowels and “h” and “d”)

Preparation (Plan ahead, be ready right at the beginning of class, come early if you need to.)

Completeness (Use details, make sure you have all the elements.)

Extra points for creativity, extra information and memorized info.

**Suggestions / other guidelines:**

PRACTICE saying things ahead of time - so you can speak fluidly and not stumble over unfamiliar words

Please plan ahead and get things ready early - I will be glad to help you before or after school - but not at the beginning of class when you should be ready to go already. Come to the lab to get help.

If you are using unusual or unfamiliar words in any part of your bienvenida - write them on the board ahead of time with definitions for the class.

**DO NOT USE A COMPUTER TRANSLATOR** – dictionary is OK

If you have a fluent speaker help you - please make sure you understand and know what you are saying.

Use the handouts from class – they have the structure and vocab you need to accomplish all tasks in the bienvenida.

If you are not prepared the day you signed up for – you may do it another day for ½ credit.
