

FUTURE

1. general future - "I'll do something"

use regular present tense + vocabulary - I'll sleep tomorrow = duermo mañana

2. intended future - "I'm going to do something"

ir + a + verb (unconjugated) I'm going to sleep = Voy a dormir

3. specific - goal, commitment, predicting future - "will do something"

add the ending on to the infinitive verb - I WILL sleep = Dormiré

All verbs use the same endings (-ar/-er/-ir)

é	emos	example:	seré	seremos
ás	éis		serás	seréis
á	án		será	serán

Irregulars in Future

Make the change to the verb, then use the regular future tense endings.

caber - cabr	poner - pondr	decir - dir	Example:	
haber - habr	salir - saldr	hacer - har	tendré	tendremos
poder - podr	tener - tendr		tendrás	tendréis
querer - querr	valer - valdr		tendrá	tendrán
saber - sabr	venir - vendr			

Mañana **habrá** una prueba.

Tomorrow **there will be** a quiz.

La semana que viene Juan y María se **besarán**

Next week Juan and Maria **will kiss**.

En cinco años **tendré** un trabajo muy bueno.

In 5 years **I will have** a very good job.

CONDITIONAL

“**would do** something if/but...” - depends on a condition.

Add endings to **infinitive** verb.

All verbs use the same endings

ía	íamos	example: besaría	besaríamos
ías	íais	besarías	besaríais
ía	ían	besaría	besarían

Conditional uses the same irregulars as future tense:

saber - sabr	poner - pondr	decir - dir
querer - querr	salir - saldr	hacer - har
haber - habr	tener - tendr	
poder - podr	venir - vendr	
caber - cabr	valer - valdr	

Estudiaría pero no tengo tiempo.

I would study but I don't have time

Si no fueras pelirrojo, **tendrías** una A.

If you weren't a redhead, you **would have** an A

Iríamos a España si tuviéramos el dinero.

We **would go** to Spain if we had the money

remember si = if

sí = yes

pero = but

si fuera = if I were

si tuviera = if I had

si pudiera = if I could

1. Si fuera el/la dictador(a) del mundo (If I were the world dictator...)

Example: If I were the world dictator I **would live** in the Alhambra and I **would have** a whole bunch of minions that **would do** everything I ask.

Si fuera la dictadora del mundo **viviría** en la Alhambra y **tendría** un montón de subordinantes que **harían** todo lo que pidiera.

2. Si tuviera \$1,000,000,000,000... (If I had \$1,000,000,000,000 ...)

Example: If I had \$1,000,000,000,000, I would give new cars to all the people in my family.

Si tuviera \$1,000,000,000,000, **daría** coches nuevos a todas las personas en mi familia.

3. Si tuviera un deseo... (If I had a wish...)

Example: If I had a wish, I would speak fluently in all the languages in the world including animal languages, then I could talk with my dog.

Si tuviera un deseo, **hablaría** con fluidez todos los idiomas del mundo incluso idiomas de animales, entonces **podría** hablar con my perro.

4. Si pudiera _____, _____ (If I could _____, I would _____)

infinitive conditional

Example: If I could fly, I would never arrive late to school.

Si pudiera volar, nunca **llegaría** tarde a la escuela.

5. _____, pero _____ (excuse) (I would _____, but _____)

conditional present

Example: I would do my homework, but I have to shave the cat.

Haría mi tarea, pero tengo que afeitarse el gato.
